A memorial service will be held at a later date for Mr. Keenan Wayne Duffy, 39, who entered eternal rest, Tuesday, April 14, 2020 at Our Lady of Lourdes Regional Medical Center in Lafayette, LA due to complications from COVID-19.

Keenan aka Big Duff was a 1998 graduate of Carencro High School. He worked at AT&T Call Center (formerly Cingular Wireless) for over 19 years.

He loved to hunt, fish, cook in his black pot and fuss with his father-in-law about who's sauce picante was better. No matter what holiday came around he was sure to make his rounds.
