Mrs. Cecilia R. Dauterive, age 91, entered eternal rest on Friday, May 8, 2026, at Senior Village Nursing Home.

Mrs. Dauterive was a lifelong member of Holy Ghost Catholic Church. She was active in a number of ministries and organizations including: St. Joseph Alter Society, Senior Sodality, Holy Ghost Adult Choir, CCD teacher and money counter. She was a member of the Knights of Peter Claver Ladies Auxiliary Holy Ghost Court 8 for over 50 years and a charter member of the Meritorious Fourth Degree Ladies of Grace Chapter 7.

Mrs. Dauterive graduated from Holy Ghost High School. At an early age, she knew her career path would be in education. This passion led her to attend THE Southern University and A&M College in Baton Rouge, LA where she received her Bachelors Degree and Master's +30 Degree in Elementary Education. She retired from Acadia Parish School System after teaching second grade for 26.5 years. Then, taught a few years at North Elementary before retiring again.
