She was a graduate of Southern University with a Bachelor degree in Elementary Education. Later she obtained a Master's degree from Columbia Teachers College in New York. During her teaching career she taught at several schools in St. Landry Parish including St. Peter Claver (Grand Coteau Elem.), Southwest Elem., Park Vista Elem., and East Jr. High.

In her active years Cora belonged to several professional and religious organizations. Included in her organizations are: National Association of University Women; St. Landry Parish Retired Teachers Association; Louisiana Association of Retired Teachers; the Legion of Mary; Knights of Peter Claver Ladies Auxiliary; Ladies of Grace 4th Degree, KPC.
