



Mrs. Elise Durousseau

December 4, 1922 - October 12, 2020

Funeral services for Elise Durousseau, 97, will be held at 11:00 AM, Monday, October 19, 2020, at Holy Ghost Catholic Church in Opelousas, Louisiana. Interment will be at St. Landry Church Mausoleum. The family will receive visitors from 7:30 AM to 10:45 AM, October 19, 2020, at Williams Funeral Home.

On Monday, October 12, 2020, Elise awoke as she always did – giving thanks for another day. Though her body was tired, her spirit was full of gratitude to be able to draw another breath. In the late morning hours, Elise passed away peacefully when the Lord called her into His eternal care after 97 years. She was a loving mother and a woman of deep religious faith who devoted her life to her family and her church.

Elise was born on December 4, 1922 in Port Barre, Louisiana, the eighth of eleven children to Fannelia Keyes Comeaux and David Comeaux. She attended Holy Ghost Catholic School and received her Bachelor of Arts and Master of Education degree from Southern University. During her teaching career, Elise taught at Garland Elementary in Whiteville; Sylvester Elementary in Sunset; Hyland Elementary in Plaquemine Point; and Northeast Elementary in Opelousas before retiring from the St. Landry Parish School System in 1986 with over forty years of dedicated service.

In her active years, Elise belonged to numerous professional and religious organizations. She was a member of the St. Landry Parish Association of Retired Educators, St. Landry Retired Teachers Association, The National

Association of University Women, and the Ladies Auxiliary of Knights of Peter Claver.

For many years, Elise was deeply involved at Holy Ghost Church where she served as Coordinator of the Marion Choir, President of the Holy Family Alumni Association, Treasurer of St. Joseph's Society, and Treasurer of the Knights of Peter Claver Fourth Degree Ladies of Grace. She was also a Eucharistic minister, a lector, a religion teacher, and a parish council member. Her greatest ministry, however, was making hundreds of pies for the weekly Tuesday night Bingo which earned her the affectionate nickname "the pie lady" for her delicious sweet potato pies that were a favorite of many. For her unconditional service to the church and community, Elise was awarded the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Award in 2008.

Elise is survived by one son, Felix Michael Durousseau ; one daughter, Bernadette Ann (Clifton) Carmon; two grandsons, Michael Durousseau and Mark Carmon (Heidi); one granddaughter, Alana Carmon-Bobb (Brandon); and five great-grand children; Alyssa, Brooklyn, Ashlynn, Isabella, and Maverick. She is also survived by numerous nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Elise was preceded in death by her husband, Felix Durousseau; parents, David and Fanellia Comeaux; one daughter-in-law, Venecia (Judy) Durousseau; two brothers, Joseph Rodney Comeaux and James Comeaux; eight sisters, Anna Comeaux, Ida Comeaux, Elizabeth Comeaux, Lucretia Thompson, Irma Frank, Louise Washington, Cora Jones, and Sister Mary Juliana, SSF.

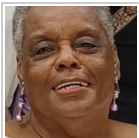

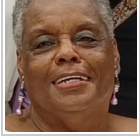

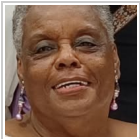
