She utilized her giftings and talents to create and manage a home health care program, where she managed providers serving Houston's elite community, most notably, Attorney Glen Rosenbaum, a Patron of the Arts in Houston, Texas. Mrs. Felozia retired in 2010, where she spent her remaining years loving and providing for her family, counseling by phone, and serving the Lord. She departed her earthly home on July 8, 2023, and she will be mourned and greatly missed by her family, friends, and community for such a great loss.
