She spoke of her sister moving in down the hall. Ms Jolivette loved her birds, and had a bird feeder outside her window. She would call me sometimes to request that on my next visit, not to make a special trip, but when I could, that she could use some more birdseed. And when I would visit the facility, as I walked up the front sidewalk, I would wave at the window behind the feeder, because that's where she sat in her chair watching for incomers. Also, as she learned of my poultry farm, she spoke of a childhood memory of ducks that her family had. And she said that she always wondered why the ducks would sometimes "reach their necks out" cranking back and forth. She said that she asked her dad about that when she was young. And he replied, "You don't need to know nothing 'bout that; get on back to the house!" We would laugh about that story. Lastly, I was so glad to see that the one birthday party, that Sr Village puts on monthly, that she attended, was the month of her birthday. She was recognized at the honoree's table.
