He looked up to "Parrain" and grew up to be very much like him. Granddad and Parrain were Jordan's father figures throughout life.

Jordan attended Woodmere Elementary School in Harvey, LA and Butler Elementary School in Marrero, LA. He also attended L.W. Higgins High School. Jordan worked on the Mississippi River as a deckhand, then went on to receive his Captain's License.

Jordan was a kind and thoughtful young man, who had many friends. He took great pride in his appearance. Jordan loved to wear the latest fashions and had an extensive tennis shoe collection.

Jordan absolutely loved cars. Nothing made him happier than to cruise around town with his daughter in his freshly washed car. He also enjoyed boat rides and tubing. Jordan found peace in the water and would spend hours on the boat with Parrain.

Jordan had one daughter, Jha'lai Nibbs (age 2), whom he adored. He was a very loving and attentive father.

Two points of extreme sadness in his life occurred in August of 2010 when he lost his mother, Tiffany, at 39 years of age; and the loss of his grandmother, Peggy, earlier this month.

Jordan loved his family dearly, and took pride in being a pillar of support to his siblings. He had a heart of gold and was always ready and willing to help others. Jordan was loved by all who knew him.

Jordan Christopher Nibbs, age 25, entered into eternal rest in Opelousas, LA on Sunday, December 17, 2017. 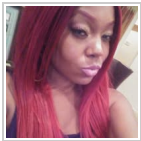
