Bobb, 93, was a native of Carencro, LA, and was a longtime resident of Grand Coteau, LA. She passed away on Tuesday, October 27, 2015, at her home, surrounded by her loved ones.

Mrs. Lillie was a very loving Mother, Grandmother, Great Grandmother, Foster Mother, sister, aunt, cousin, housekeeper and neighbor. She loved family gatherings at her home, cooking for family and neighboring children. She also loved spoiling her grandchildren. She served as surrogate Mother and Grandmother to many neighboring children. She raised her family to love going to church, school and work. She thought her children the meaning of caring for others regardless of race. Her pastime love was listening to zydeco music, dancing and sewing.

She was also an adopted mother to Harold Davis (Mercedes), Leonville, LA.

She also worked for Maurene Goudeau and the late Gerald Goudeau, of Lafayette, Louisiana, for over thirty years. Ms. Lillie, as she was affectionately known, by the family, assisted in rearing nine additional children (six boys and three girls).

She was preceded in death by her husband, Joseph Bobb, Sr.; her parents: Edmond and Edia Livings; one son, PFC Chester Bobb; two daughters: Elenora Edwards (late Ernest); Myrtle Mae Guillory; two brothers Fayno and Whitney Livings; and three sisters: Lorena Andrus, Justine Journet and Beulah Rubin.

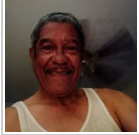
