Interment will be in Bellevue Memorial Park. Rev. Rofinus Jas, S.V.D. will officiate at the Mass of Christian burial.

Norma was the 5th child of 11 born to Hazel and Weston Singleton. She was not ashamed of where she came from. She often talked about how she picked cotton as a youngster and used the money she made to pay for school clothes. She started working at an early age babysitting for different doctors and business people in the Opelousas. She also worked cleaning offices downtown. Her profession was that of an Executive Secretary. She worked as school secretary at Northeast Elementary until she decided to venture out to California. At a time when young ladies didn't go out on their own, Norma decided to move to California. She paved the way for her younger sisters to do the same. While in California, she continued her education receiving a college degree and secured a job as an Executive Secretary for Peralta Colleges.

Norma was known as the "fashionista" of our family. In her younger days, she purchased a sewing machine and made her own clothes. Her nickname was "The Fox". She loved fashion and could always be seen in some fashionable

outfit. Everyone in the family would await her arrival every year at Christmas time. She always arrived looking fabulous and bearing gifts.

Norma LOVED children. She always gave special attention to the nieces and nephews and any other children she came in contact with. She even called them "Sugar Babies". And the children loved her just as much as she loved them.

Norma was the ultimate hostess. She loved welcoming people into her home. She was a great cook and an even better baker. She could take a recipe and make it taste better than the original and look just as beautiful as it did in the book.

She was always a caring and loving individual. She decided to retire a year earlier than planned so that she could come back to Louisiana and care for our ailing mother. She took care of Mother until Mother died. After Mother's death, she decided to go back to work and took a job as secretary at South Street Elementary. She eventually moved on to the school board office where she worked as a payroll specialist. She did that job until her husband became ill and she became his caretaker. She cared for Donald until his death.

Norma also was a dog lover. Even though she didn't own one, she loved taking care of Jean Pierre and Whitley whenever she had the opportunity.

Norma had a very strong faith and believed in the power of prayer. She could often be seen with a rosary bead in her hand or her little book that was so full of prayer cards that she had to secure it with a rubber band. She was a firm believer in her faith.

Norma was loved by many, many people besides family. She left a lasting impression wherever she went. She will definitely be missed!

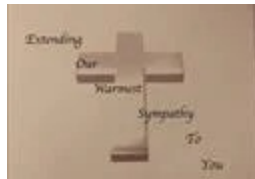
