For 30 years, Ralph was a member of the zydeco band, Terrance Simien and The Zydeco Experience. When not traveling and performing, he spent time painting and doing carpentry work, which he learned from his father at a young age. He died peacefully, in his sleep, after a performance in Louisville, Kentucky.

Mr. Fontenot is survived by four sisters, Barbara Joseph (Eddie), Sheila Papillion (Phillip), Monica Henderson (Wade) and Dawn Bias (Wade); his former wife, Annie M. Fontenot; a stepson, Simon Kuhn; 7 nephews, 4 nieces, 7 great nephews, 4 great nieces, aunts, uncles, other relatives, his band family and many friends.

Mr. Fontenot was preceded in death by his parents, Arthur & Eltra Mae Fontenot.
