Willie was born to Sanders Lazare, and Francis Marcel Lazare of Leonville, LA on November 25, 1923. Due to the early death of his father he served as a father figure to his two brothers and two sisters. He later joined the military and was a veteran of World War II. Willie married Verdna Mae Auzenne on December 26, 1954 where they shared almost 60 years together. To this union 13 children were born.

He attended vocational school and obtained a certificate in Farm Mechanics which covered welding, carpentry and mechanics. He was known as a “jack-of-all trades” and was a trusted mechanic to family and friends in the community. He worked as a heavy equipment technician for several construction companies in the Baton Rouge area for over 30 years. To relax, he enjoyed hunting and Sunday evening card games with family and friends. He was an active member of the Knights of St. Peter Claver Council #46 and a lifelong member of St. Katherine’s Catholic Church.
